Dear participants,

Here you can find some important information about the activity, logistics and accommodation for our training course, for participants coming from Austria, Croatia, Germany, Bosnia and Herzegovina and Montenegro.

Meeting point

Our meeting point is **"HI Hostel Zadar"**. The address of the hostel is Obala Kneza Branimira 10a, Zadar 23000, Croatia. We are expecting you on the 25th of October 2026 during the day. The welcome session will start in the evening (the exact starting time will be agreed with participants, based on arrival times), followed by dinner at 19:00.

The departure is envisioned for the morning of the 3rd of November 2026, after breakfast.

Participants are expected to attend the full duration of the TC (25th October - 3rd November 2026).

For all information about booking your tickets and coming to Zadar, please contact us at **info@spin-okret.org**. We kindly ask you to choose an ecologically and economically friendly means of transport, if possible.

Please remember that we expect you to arrive before/for dinner time on 25th October 2026, and to stay until breakfast on 3rd November 2026, when choosing your arrival/departure times.

Travel reimbursement

Travel costs will be reimbursed only for the cheapest way of transport and for return tickets, up to the maximum amount per participant shown in the table below (per the Erasmus+ Distance Calculator and your country of origin). Travel expenses are covered by the organisers 100% up to this maximum, including bank transfer and other appropriate fees (for original tickets by plane, bus, train or ferry - NOT taxi and NOT private car).

For participants travelling from Austria, Croatia, Bosnia and Herzegovina and Montenegro (distances under 500 km), the preferred means of transport is land transport, such as train and/or bus. If air travel is chosen instead for these distances, it will be reimbursed at 60% of the airfare, in line with the project's principle of environmental awareness and protection. Participants travelling from Germany may use train, bus or plane, up to the maximum grant shown above.

Participants must keep all travel documents (tickets, travel agency invoices and boarding passes), as reimbursement can only be made on the basis of presented documents.

Travel reimbursement will be done by bank transfer after you return home and send us the ORIGINAL boarding passes and tickets (and after you submit the filled-in evaluation form of the training course). When buying a ticket, please ask for an additional bill as well, if possible.

Further rules regarding booking of tickets and reimbursement:

- Only the cheapest tickets will be reimbursed. We will not cover tickets with deviation from the direct route, extra unnecessary stops and layovers, seat reservation fees, flexible tariff tickets, extra travel insurance, priority boarding fees, local bus baggage, handwritten tickets or bianco nota bills.
- Only tickets purchased online will be reimbursed. We can't cover travel agency fees or accept travel agency invoices for reimbursement.
- We can't reimburse taxis or private cars - only public transport will be covered.
- You can arrive a maximum of 1 day before the activity and depart a maximum of 1 day after, if you want to spend more time in Croatia on your own, provided the tickets on these days are not more expensive than on the official travel days.

- Please don't buy your tickets before we approve them. If your planned travel itinerary differs from 25th October - 3rd November 2026, or if you are travelling from a different town/country than your sending organisation, please inform us in advance so we can approve your tickets and travel costs.

Practical information

The unit of currency in Croatia is the Euro (EUR). It is possible to pay with a credit card at most places (restaurants, bars, supermarkets), but we still advise you to carry some cash with you.

Accommodation

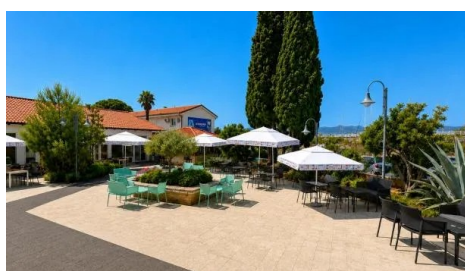
All participants will be accommodated in “**HI Hostel Zadar**”. The hostel is situated in the touristic area “Borik”, 5 kilometres from the main bus/train station and city centre. It has a seminar hall, baggage room, internet access and a tourist info point, and is located in an area with many restaurants, bars and pubs.

We will be placed in 3-bed rooms with private bathrooms. The training course sessions will be held in the same building, and there is wifi in both common areas and rooms.

Full board (breakfast, lunch and dinner) is covered daily, together with coffee breaks during the working sessions.
